1974 Reorganized as Seoul Industrial University
1975 Oversight committee transferred from Seoul Board of Education to Seoul Metropolitan Government

1980

1981 Renamed as Seoul City University
1982 Established Graduate School of Urban Administration
1987 Renamed as University of Seoul, promoted to a comprehensive university with 4 colleges and 22 departments

Application Schedule: Twice a year (April & October)

Method of Evaluation

[Undergraduates] 100% document-based (excluding departments with practical examinations)

[Graduates] Documents & interview or documents & performance test

Scholarships

[Undergraduates] Full-tuition scholarship for top 10 percent

Half-tuition scholarship between the 10 and 20 percent

[Graduates] Full-tuition scholarship for doctoral degree according to scholastic ranks in each department

Half-tuition scholarship for master's degree according to scholastic ranks in each department

Housing: On-campus dormitory (upon availability) or off-campus housing

Exchange & Visiting Student Programs

Eligibility: International students nominated by partner universities worldwide

Seoul International Summer & Winter Schools

Eligibility: International students nominated by partner universities worldwide

Application: 100% online

Academics & Schedules

[Seoul International Summer School I] 4 weeks in July

▶ “Business in Korean Perspective” or “Korean Culture Studies”, each for 2 courses with 3 credits (45 class hours) each

▶ 1 of the 2 courses can be changed to Beginning Korean Language course

▶ 4 cultural field trips

[Seoul International Summer School II] 2 weeks in early August

▶ 8 special lectures on Korea’s various aspects

▶ 8 Korean Language lectures according to student’s level of proficiency

▶ 3 cultural field trips

[Seoul International Winter School] 2 weeks in mid-February

▶ 8 special lectures on Korea’s various aspects

▶ 8 Korean Language lectures according to student’s level of proficiency

▶ 3 cultural field trips

Peer Advocates: UOS Korean students who help new-coming international students

Housing: On-campus dormitory 100% guaranteed

Korean Language and Culture Program (KLCP)

Schedule: 10-week (200 hours) of lecture through Monday to Friday (4 hours a day)

4 times a year (short-term programs in August for 1 or 2 weeks and 1 week in December-January)

Eligibility: High school graduates or equivalent educational backgrounds

Size of Class: 10 – 16 students

Levels: 6 (Level 1 – Level 6)

Activities: Field trips, cultural experiences, speaking practice with UOS Korean students, student counseling, etc.

Scholarships: Full, 50%, 20%, 10% tuition scholarships available

Housing: On-campus dormitory (upon availability) or off-campus housing
