### HOW TO GET TO LILLE?

#### PARIS

- International Airport Roissy – Charles de Gaulle
- Train (SNCF) to Lille Flandres or Lille Europe.

#### BRUSSELS

- Zaventem or Charleroi airport
- Shuttle to Lille

### COST OF LIVING

- Accommodation: 500 euros/month
- Other expenses: 200 euros/month (bills, food, insurance, transportation, activities)
